



NOTICE OF RACE



Event: 2010 Novice (Pro-Am) Regatta
Host: HILL COUNTRY YACHT CLUB (HCYC)
Date: Saturday, June 26, 2010

Eligibility: **Novice** skippers may be either novice or seasoned sailors but may **not** have won a trophy in any race or series of races conducted on Canyon Lake. **Pro** skippers may have won a trophy. HCYC membership is not a requirement for race entry. Non-HCYC member entrants and crew are welcome to the HCYC facility.

Rules: This race will be governed by the RACING RULES OF SAILING 2009 –2012, this Notice of Race, and by the current version of the Canyon Lake Sailing Instructions as modified for HCYC use. Pro Skippers may **not** helm the boat. Other changes or modifications to the above rules and sailing instructions may be announced at the Skipper's Meeting.

Proposed Classes: J-22, PHRF Spinnaker, Non-spinnaker, PHRF Cruiser and PHRF Big Boats. Three (3) or more boats may constitute a fleet. Actual fleets will be set and announced at the Skipper's Meeting.

Races & Course: The Regatta will be held on Saturday, June 26, 2010. Three races are planned for the Regatta. The course for each race will be posted on the stern of the committee boat. The course will be set at the discretion of the Race Committee. The starting area will be in the cove between Canyon Park & Potters Creek Park. Any change to the starting area will be announced at the Skipper's Meeting.

Trophies: Trophies purchased will be based upon pre-registrations received as of Tuesday, June 22, 2010.

3-4 boats = 1 trophy; 5-7 = 2; 8-9 = 3; 10-13 = 4; 14-16 = 5; 17-19 = 6; 20 & over = 7

Or the actions of others, during my participation and support of the above described event taking place on the date(s) noted above. I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless HCYC, its officers, officials, and members for any and all claims arising from my actions or omissions and the actions and omissions of others during my participation and support of the above described event taking place on the date(s) noted above.

I will inform any and all crew members on my yacht of this waiver. I will also inform and instruct them on their responsibilities for safety, and I will obtain a similar waiver and indemnity, on the form provide by HCYC, before allowing such crew member to participate in this event. I agree that this waiver and indemnity is binding on me, on my heirs, representatives, successors and assigns. Each person on board during the event shall be deemed a crew person for all purposes. I certify that my yacht has the proper insurance and operational safety gear aboard in accordance with state and federal regulations including but not limited to any and all requirements of the U.S. Coast Guard. I FURTHER CERTIFY THAT I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS WAIVER AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT AS EVIDENCED BY MY SIGNATURE BELOW. The persons listed on the back (or separate sheet of paper) are serving as crew on the above-named vessel in the above identified race.
